Tourist potential of Russky Island to be presented at EEF 2019

The development project provides for construction of hotels, yacht clubs and sports venues. In the future the island plans to host international marathons, triathlons, runs and other competitions. According to Oleg Kozhemyako, Governor of Primorye Territory, the Ministry of Defence will transfer almost the whole territory of Russky Island to regional and city authorities. EEF regional session in Primorye discussed tourism development in the Far East

The EEF regional session was held in Vladivostok as part of the 5th Pacific Tourist Forum. At the event Z. Doguzova, head of the Federal Agency for Tourism, supported the suggestion to extend electronic visas for foreigners coming to the Far East from 8 to 14 days. The Republic of Buryatia will present major projects in mining, processing, textile production, agro-industrial sector, and tourism. According to the head of the regional government Alexey Mishenin, the projects will be of interest not only for Russian, but also for Chinese, Japanese and South-Korean investors.

Russian government to allocate 4.9 billion roubles for construction of Amur methanol production plant

Yury Trutney announced a decision to allocate 4.9 billion roubles from the federal budget for construction of infrastructure for the future production plant. The project is being implemented based on a railway oil loading terminal in the town of Skovorodino in the Amur Region. The output is planned to reach around 1 billion tonnes a year, with 270 new jobs. Private investment into the project will be 49 billion roubles. https://tass.ru/ekonomika/6476182

Additional 22 billion roubles to be allocated for the development of Far Eastern regions

The funds allocated by the Russian Government as part of the state programme 'Social and economic development of the Far East and the Baikal Region' will be used for social, engineering and transport infrastructure of the Republic of Buryatia and Zabaikalsky Krai, as well as increase of inter-budgetary transfers for the Primorye Territory.

Over 60,000 foreigners visited the Far East with electronic visas

According to the Ministry for the Development of the Russian Far East, since the introduction of the simplified vise regime almost 61,000 foreigners from 15 countries have visited the Far Eastern Federal District. Since the beginning of the year over 20,000 electronic visas have been issued, and 16,000 used them. Russian Government added new land plots for four investment projects to the ASEZ territory. The projects are related to tourism, construction, fish processing and vessel repairs. The total cost of projects will reach 660 million roubles, and around 240 new jobs will be created.

New tourist cluster to emerge in Kamchatka

The Federal Agency for Tourism supported the initiative to create 'Three volcanoes' park in Kamchatka. The project worth almost 40 billion roubles should become a centre of attraction for tourists: in 2024, it is planned to attract up to 170,000 new tourists, whereas by 2037 this figure should reach 460,000. Private investment into the park will be around 15 billion roubles, with 1,000 new jobs. The growth of tourist flow between 2024 and 2037 is expected to bring in additional 135 billion roubles to the regional budget.

Earlier, at EEF 2018, Russian President set tasks to open engineering divisions of major Russian companies on Russky Island.
