

Russian-Chinese Relations to Gain A New Trajectory at EEF 2018

7,000 Hotel Rooms Ready for the Participants of EEF

For most comfortable accommodation of the participants, EEF organizers made agreements on booking rooms with 22 Vladivostok hotels and the FEFU campus. 1,800 rooms were arranged in Vladivostok hotels, and over 4,400 are situated on the campus of the FEFU.

Experts Discussed How to Improve Quality of Live in the Russian Far East

The roundtable 'Developing Human Capital in the Russian Far East: Problems and Solutions' was held on 20 July as part of the lead up to the 4th Eastern Economic Forum. Minister for the Development of the Russian Far East Alexander Kozlov, regional administration members, professional skills development specialists, and investors implementing their own projects, attended the event.

In the next three years 55.8 billion roubles will be spent on social development in the Russian Far East. The funds will go towards infrastructure (preschools, schools, hospitals, sports complexes, territorial prosperity, roads, etc.) and equipment. As Alexander Kozlov noted, these measures are meant to improve the quality of life in the district and to stimulate the flow of skilled workers to Far Eastern enterprises.

Vladimir Putin Signed the Law on Extending Vladivostok Free Port Regime

The new document stipulates for the expansion of the Vladivostok Free Port (FPV) regime to the Sovetsko-Gavansky District of the Khabarovsk Krai. The Free Port regime is now effective in 22 municipal districts of the Far East.

Experts are certain that this will lead to the implementation of 15 investment projects worth 54.5 billion roubles in the Sovetskaya Gavan. Over 4.3 billion roubles in tax revenues and fees to budgets of different levels are expected to come in the period of eight years. Establishment of new enterprises will create over 1,800 jobs.

Yury Trutnev: New Development Mechanisms Help Put in Place 1,375 Investment Projects in Russia's Far East Worth 3.8 Trillion Roubles

On 17 July 2018 Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Federation and Presidential Plenipotentiary Envoy to the Far Eastern Federal District made this announcement during the meeting of the Sub-Commission for Investment Project Implementation in the Far East and Baikal Region under the Governmental Commission on the Socioeconomic Development of the Far East and Baikal Region. The meeting took place in Moscow.

The implementation of these projects will create 127,000 new jobs before 2025. According to Mr Trutnev, 129 industrial facilities with total investment volume of 140 billion roubles have already been commissioned.
