

At the St. Petersburg International Economic Forum, Alexander Galushka held a meeting with Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman, India's Minister of State for Commerce and Industry. The head of the Ministry for the Development of the Russian Far East presented projects in various economic areas: diamonds, oil and gas chemistry, the mining industry and energy. In turn, India confirmed its intention to send a delegation to EEF 2017.

Improving the demographic situation to be discussed at EEF 2017

One strategic session of the Thirds Eastern Economic Forum will be dedicated to improving the demographic situation in the Far East. According to Sergei Kachayev, Deputy Minister for the Development of Russian Far East, the EEF will discuss three blocks: specific measures to be adopted in the regions for implementing the Far East demographic development concept up to 2025; best demographic practices; projects selected at the presidential grant competition for developing civil society and at the "Good deeds in a good land!" programme.

Yuri Trutnev: Specific results of the development of the Far East must be demonstrable by the Third Eastern Economic Forum

Yuri Trutnev, Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Federation – Presidential Plenipotentiary Envoy to the Far Eastern Federal District, summed up the work done on socioeconomic development of the Far East in 2016. Yuri Trutnev said that last year set a record in preparing the regulatory and legal framework for the macroregion's advanced socioeconomic development. Seven laws and 15 acts of the Government of the Russian Federation were adopted. 18 more laws are currently under approval.

According to Yuri Trutnev, in 2016, four advanced special economic zones were established and 72 new agreements signed with residents; Free Port Vladivostok gained 142 new residents. Overall, the Far East received RUB 176 billion in investments.

Chinese Investor Support Centre to be established in the Far East

The Chinese Investor Support Centre in the Far Eastern Federal District will open in July this year. The Centre is to be founded by the Far East Investment and the Export Agency on the Russian side and by China's International Enterprises Association on the Chinese side. Alexander Galushka says the Centre will be a one-stop-shop for services relating to working with Chinese business.

Development of international transport corridors in the Far East discussed at SPIEF

The parties to the talks stressed that the managing company should have the resources for resolving pressing issues, including ones pertaining to the customs agencies of the two countries.

A Fund for application of high-tech in development and manufacturing to be established in the Far East

The new development institution will offer loans to Far Eastern companies that develop promising technologies; it will also finance projects related to technology transfers from abroad and to expanding and modernizing technological products.

The Fund is intended to speed up development of innovations and expand manufacturing application of cutting-edge technologies in the Far East. The Far East Development Fund, Rosnano and the Russian Venture Company will take part in establishing the Fund, which will have an initial volume of RUB 5 billion.

Council of the People's Republic of China is slated for signing in July, during Chairman Xi Jinping's visit to Moscow. Russia has confirmed that Chinese state-owned companies will be offered support through creation of a favourable investment regime in the Far East. Participation in the Primorye-1 and Primorye-2 international transport corridors project is expected to hold the greatest promise for China's state-owned companies.

Subsidized mortgages to be introduced in the Far East in 2017

To anchor the population of the Far East, to attract new residents to the macroregion and to increase the birth rate, new subsidized mortgages are to be introduced. Under the programme, the mortgages will carry a 7% interest rate for buying housing on the new homes market. Other support measures are also under consideration, such as payments to young families to reduce the interest rate on the birth of their first and second children and complete mortgage pay-off on the birth of their third child.

A unified automated Far Eastern investment project support system becomes operational in Russia

The system covers 600 investment projects currently implemented in the Far East. The program involves setting up a personal account for each investor.

The system allows investors to resolve problems online, and to interact remotely with the Ministry for the Development of the Russian Far East and with the Far East development institutions: the Far East Development Corporation, Agency for Development of Human Capital in Far East, Far East Investment and Export Agency.

RUB 50 billion to be allocated for creating advanced special economic zones

Over the next few years, the Government of the Russian Federation plans to allocate RUB 30 billion out of the budget to establish and develop advanced special economic zones (ASEZs); another RUB 20 billion will be allocated from other funding sources; this announcement was made by Dmitry Medvedev at a meeting dedicated to the preliminary results of establishing Far Eastern ASEZs in 2015–2017. The Prime Minister noted that this money would be used to build roads, power grids and the utility infrastructure.

Chinese state-owned corporation intends to invest over USD 1 billion in building a cellulose and paper plant in the Far East

ChinaChengtong is to build a cellulose and paper plant in Amursk, Khabarovsk Area. The investment will total USD 1 billion and the project will create 1,500 new jobs. The company will produce several types of cellulose for manufacturing paper and cardboard. The company plans to receive assistance in obtaining raw materials and in calculating logistics and transport capacities. The company's products are slated to be exported to China. The company will work in an advanced special economic zone.

A Korean investor to invest USD 1 m in fish processing in Primorye

TyoKen Trade Company is interested in obtaining the status of a resident of Free Port Vladivostok. The fish processing plant will use Kamchatka raw materials and export its products to South Korea. The first stage calls for 128 new jobs. The plant will process 8–10 thousand tonnes of Alaska Pollock a year.

Construction of the new passenger terminal will start in 2017. A consortium of Japanese investors headed by SojitzCorporation is slated to take part in the project. The airport will have a capacity of up to 3 million passengers a year. The project's total cost is RUB 4.2 billion.

The Government of Russia approves the new Russky Island development concept

On the sidelines of SPIEF 2017, Alexander Galushka stated that eight investors had already confirmed their intention to implement investment projects in the Russky Island advanced special economic zone slated to be launched by 2018. The private investments in these projects will total RUB 50 billion.

The development concept envisages developing the Far Eastern Federal University and building an International Cooperation Centre with a congress and exhibition centre for holding, among other events, the annual Eastern Economic Forum. Under the plan, Russky Island is to become a site for developing high-tech projects.

The world's biggest helium logistics centre to be established in the Nadezhdinskaya ASEZ

An Agreement on establishing a logistics centre for servicing helium containers has been signed by Gazprom Gazenergoset Gely, resident of the advanced special economic zone, and the Far East Development Corporation. The project will provide for helium exports to Asia Pacific.

Investments will total RUB 5.153 billion. Construction of the enterprise will create 300 new jobs. The logistics centre is to be launched in 2021.
