EEF 2017 to address intellectual property rights

Head of the Federal Service for Intellectual Property (Rospatent) Grigory Ivlev, heads of patent offices of the PRC, Japan, Korea, Mongolia, Belarus, Azerbaijan, Armenia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and representatives of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) and other international patent organizations will participate in the EEF, which will feature the international Forum "Intellectual Property: Instruments of Regional Development."

The forum of young entrepreneurs Point of Attraction – the Far East will take place on 5 September, on the starting day of the EEF. Some 400 people, mostly young businessmen under the age of 35, will participate.

The agenda includes discussions of a range of issues, including ways for Russian companies to access the markets of the Asia-Pacific Region, export of the best Russian and international entrepreneurial practices to the Far East, and exchange between entrepreneurs of experience in using new economic mechanisms – Advanced Special Economic Zones, the Free Port of Vladivostok and the Far Eastern Hectare.

A Woodworking factory to be unveiled in Komsomolsk Advanced Special Economic Zone

The opening ceremony of the company will be held on the sidelines of the Eastern Economic Forum. The sawmill is part of an integrated investment project for deep wood conversion being implemented on the Amur platform in the Komsomolsk Priority Development Area.

The factory will manufacture glued laminated lumber, furniture board, veneer, chipboard, biofuel, wooden window and door units, as well as flooring and other products.

Gold-mining factory built in Russia's pole of cold to be launched during EEF

The Tarynsky Mining and Processing Works (GOK) on the Drashnoe deposit in Yakutia has been completed and is ready to be launched. The project has been implemented with infrastructure support from the government, which can be enjoyed by investors in the Far East by decision of the Russian Government.

Owing to state support, a power line has been built and design operations are under way to prepare for reconstruction of a highway. Investment in the project amounted to RUB 9.8 billion. The annual design capacity of the factory is 700,000 tonnes of ore and it will create 450 new jobs.
