

Republic of Korea to take part in 'Far East Street' festival at EEF 2017. The country's pavilion will hold a presentation on the 2018 Winter Olympics, which will be held in Pyeongchang. (TASS)

Chinese investors may take part in building International Cooperation Centre on Russky Island. A corresponding agreement is scheduled to be concluded at EEF 2017. (TASS)

Khabarovsk Territory to sign agreements for over RUB 60 billion at EEF. Investment in the largest project to fund the construction of the Khabarovsk bypass will amount to RUB 43 bln. (RIA Novosti)

Yakutia plans to sign 21 agreements for over RUB 7 billion at EEF 2017. The contracts will include an additional agreement with Rosneft Oil Company to fund the construction of the Small Academy of Sciences with 150 jobs. (TASS)

Primorye Territory to present Nadezhdinskaya Advanced Special Economic Zone at EEF 2017. The event will include the signing of agreements with investors who will implement new projects involving the construction of fish processing complexes as well as the manufacturing of fish products and thermal and power distribution equipment. AHML to present concept to develop Vladivostok district at Eastern Economic Forum. The concept will include a master plan for the Vladivostok metropolitan area, projects to improve public spaces in the city, and a strategy for the integrated development of Novik Bay on Russky Island. (Izvestia)

Far Eastern Federal University proposes creating talent pool from most active EEF Youth Day participants for programmes being implemented in Far East. Youth Day participants will include 400 schoolchildren, young entrepreneurs, and heads of non-profit organizations. (TASS)

The winner of the competition held by the Far East Development Corporation was the company Financial and Organizational Consulting. Potential resident of Khabarovsk Advanced Special Economic Zone to launch tyre retreading plant by autumn 2018. The company Viktoria will build a production facility with capacity to produce 10,900 types per year at the Rakitnoye site. (Interfax)

Resident of Nadezhdinskaya Advanced Special Economic Zone in Primorye Territory produces wide range of over 80 tonnes of household chemicals. The efficiency of the project being implemented by Vostok-Polikor increased by more than 30% thanks to tax benefits, the company's management said. (Primorsky.ru)
