

Igor Shuvalov invites Singaporean representatives to take part in EEF 2018

Moscow hosted the 8th meeting of the High-Level Intergovernmental Russia-Singapore Commission chaired by Igor Shuvalov and Singaporean Deputy Prime Minister and Coordinating Minister for Economic and Social Policies Tharman Shanmugaratnam.

In particular, the officials discussed the development of Russian-Singaporean relations in the Far East. The Russian side expressed its readiness to continue to support Singaporean investors in their implementation of joint projects in the Russian Far East, including within advanced special economic zones and the Free Port of Vladivostok. The Singaporean side confirmed its interest in implementing projects in Russia's Far Eastern Federal District.

The exhibition will feature an extensive cultural and business programme on the streets of Moscow and the Expocenter: the plans include the launch of several new enterprises in the advanced special economic zones of the Far East, the operation of a personnel centre with a number of new vacancies in the Far East region and a centre for the implementation of the 'Far Eastern hectare' programme as well as the Far East Seafood and Souvenirs Fair. New terminals, wholesale distribution centres as well as processing and logistics enterprises need to be built on the core of the agro-industrial and agro-food facilities that are being established in the Far East, he said.

Liquefied gas transhipment terminal to be built in Kamchatka

Novatek and the regional authorities signed an agreement on the terminal's construction. The transhipment terminal, where LNG will be loaded from Arctic gas carriers to conventional gas carriers, will have capacity of 20 million tonnes per year. The project will reduce the cost of transporting fuel produced on the Yamal and Gydan peninsulas to countries in the Asia-Pacific region. The terminal is expected to be built in 2022–2023.

Construction begins on car recycling plant in Primorye's Nadezhdinskaya ASEZ

TerminaTOR, a joint project of the Japanese investors Arai Shoji Co. Ltd., Royal AutoParts, and Sumotori group of companies, is being implemented in the Nadezhdinskaya Advanced Special Economic Zone. An agreement on the construction of the plant was signed on the sidelines of the third Eastern Economic Forum. The plant will perform the advanced processing of car and truck components: the separation of glass, plastic, metal, and other spare parts. Total investments will amount to RUB 300 million.

New enterprise opens in Amuro-Khinganskaya ASEZ

A sandwich panel production line with capacity to manufacture 22,500 tonnes per year opened in Birobidzhan. The plant's construction products will be used to build large facilities in the Jewish Autonomous Region, the Amur Region, and other regions. Total investment will amount to RUB 1.5 billion, and the project will result in the creation of 200 new jobs.
