

Government commission approves construction of bridge to Elena Island in Primorye

The bridge to Yelena Island will become one of the most important components of the Vladivostok Ring Road (VKAD), which will connect the city's central district and the Egersheld area, where the commercial sea port is located, to Russky Island.

The final decision on the construction of the Vladivostok Ring Road was announced at the 5th Eastern Economic Forum, where the Far East Investment and Export Agency and Avtodor-Invest signed an agreement.

STATE POLICY IN THE FAR EAST

Russian Ministry of Energy to present options for Baimsky Mining and Processing Plant to connect to major Baimka copper and gold deposits in Chukotka

This announcement was made by Minister for the Development of the Russian Far East Alexander Kozlov following a meeting of the Presidium of the State Commission for the Development of the Arctic in Murmansk. The Chukotka authorities expect the launch of the Baimka gold and copper deposit to double the gross regional product.

In October, Deputy Prime Minister and Russian Presidential Envoy to the Far Eastern Federal District Yury Trutnev instructed the Ministry of Energy and RusHydro to come up with mechanisms for the power connection of the Baimka ore zone, which would allow it to be developed as efficiently as possible with minimal investments from the budget.

VTB issues first Far East mortgage loans

VTB has been the first market leader to start working under the new state subsidy programme for residents of the Far East starting from 16 December. On the first day, the bank signed three loan agreements and accepted over 300 applications as part of the programme. The interest rate under the new programme is only 2% and the loan term is up to 20 years. The maximum possible loan amount is RUB 6 million with a minimum down payment of 20% of the value of the property.

Amur Region governor calls 2019 historic for region

Amur Region Governor Vasily Orlov highlighted the most important events of the outgoing year for the Amur Region, including the completion of the construction of a bridge to China, the launch of the Power of Siberia gas pipeline, and the start of construction on the second stage of the Vostochny Cosmodrome, the Amur Gas Chemical Plant, a cross-border cableway, and a new runway.

First RUB 300 million allocated to Vladivostok as Primorye Territory capital

The city became the administrative centre of the region at a session of the regional parliament in late November, which will allow Vladivostok to receive additional funding from the regional budget for the performance of functions as a regional capital.

The Primorye administration will be transformed into a government by the end of this year and will work in its new form starting from 2020.

More foreign liners and a route through Russia: How cruise tourism is developing in the Far Eastern Federal District

The Primorye Territory has set a record for the number of visits by foreign liners over the last three years, Sakhalin has received three large foreign vessels, Kamchatka is organizing expeditions along the Northern Sea Route, and the Magadan Region is building infrastructure for tourists in Nagaev Bay.

At the same time, the regions are developing the concept of a Far Eastern cruise line that is expected to take the industry to a new level.

Nikkei: Japanese companies intend to take part in construction of Far East LNG Plant

A consortium of several Japanese companies intends to take part in the construction of the Far East LNG Plant, which will be implemented as part of the Sakhalin-1 project.

The consortium will include Marubeni Itochu, Japan Petroleum Exploration, and the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry of Japan. Their final investment decision may be taken in 2021. The plant is expected to produce 35,000 square metres of OSB boards, formwork, and plywood. https://tass.ru/ekonomika/7390817

Japanese doctors teaching Far Easterners to take better care of their health

Japanese businesses are eagerly utilizing the preferential regimes and development tools that have been developed for the Far Eastern Federal District to invest in the economy of the Russian region.

For example, the medical centre JGC Hokuto Medservice LLC, which was founded by JGC Corporation and Hokuto Social Medical Corporation, has the status of a resident of the Free Port of Vladivostok.

The establishment of a Japanese rehabilitation centre in Primorye for patients in the recovery stage from strokes and injuries was discussed at the Eastern Economic Forum in 2016. In December of the same year, a Russian delegation led by President Vladimir Putin discussed this prospect in Tokyo as part of an official visit.

Russia and China launching new gas pipeline

Moscow and Beijing are launching the Power of Siberia pipeline, which will pump 38 billion cubic metres of gas each year from Russia's Kovykta and Chayandinskoye fields to the Chinese city of Heihe.

The Power of Siberia project is key to Russia's new gas policy. Whereas Europe was previously considered as the main sales market, more and more attention is now being paid to Asia, particularly to China. This not only makes it possible to generate substantial profits, but to also actively develop Siberian deposits.

A resort with 17 km of ski slopes and two cable cars is slated to be built near Goryachaya hill.

Star of the Far East Prize awarded to region's best employers, investors, Far Eastern Hectare recipients, and Khabarovsk International Airport

Russian Deputy Prime Minister and Presidential Envoy to the Far Eastern Federal District Yury Trutnev presented awards to the winners of the Star of the Far East public business award, which has been handed out for two years as part of the Days of the Far East in Moscow Festival to show that the region is a "territory of growth". Forty-eight people have won the award over this time. This year, prizes in 11 categories were awarded to journalists, volunteers, media representatives, businessmen, and participants in the Far Eastern Hectare programme.

The winner of the Territorial Development nomination was Khabarovsk Airport at which President Vladimir Putin officially opened a new terminal in September during the fifth EEF.
