31 August 2020, OTV

"Vostok" All-Russian Youth Educational Forum took place in Vladivostok

This year, the Forum offered two formats – the online one on the special Vostok platform on 3–17 August and the offline one in the Far Eastern Federal University on 22–29 August. EEF and Kim Jong-un's visit to Vladivostok spurred media interest to Primorye

Dow Jones and Smyslografia analytical agency (part of the AGT Consulting Group) published the rating of Russian regions as perceived by leading global media in 2019. Primorye Territory joined Top 10. Traditionally, positive newsworthy events related to Russian regions include news about the fuel and energy complex, speeches of the Russian President, as well as a whole range of international athletic events. Primorye Territory's position in the rating was driven by the EEF 2019 involving Prime Ministers of India and Japan, as well as negotiations between Vladimir Putin and Kim Jong-un in Vladivostok.

Roscongress Foundation and Far East Development Corporation signed a cooperation agreement

In the Far Eastern Federal District and Arctic Zone of the Russian Federation, partnering organizations will establish cooperation with representatives of Russian regions, authorized regional authorities and promote promising investment and business projects that require external financing. A permanent working group will systemize these efforts. Cooperation results will be published in news outlets and presented annually at the EEF in Vladivostok. This cooperation agreement became effective on 6 August 2020 and is valid until 31 December 2021

Primorye Territory government and Synergy Corporation signed a cooperation agreement

The signing ceremony was attended by Deputy Chairman of Primorye Territory government Konstantin Shestakov, Acting Deputy CEO of the Far East Export and Investment Agency Alikhan Khashiyev, and Vice President for Investment Policy and Government Relations Olga Grishchenko.

This agreement provides for cooperation in developing economic and human resources potential of the Far East, social and youth policies, secondary and higher education, and retraining. Mikhail Mishustin announced an upcoming approval of the Far East Development programme until 2035

Russian Prime Minister noted that the industrial growth in the Far Eastern Federal District is twice as high as on average in Russia. Mikhail Mishustin emphasized competitive advantages of the Far Eastern regions. They include unique geography and nature, large mineral deposits, opportunities to develop large industrial centres and large logistics corridors across Eurasia.

Mikhail Mishustin announced copper production volumes in Russia went up 15–20% after the launch of Baimsky Processing Plant and Mine

Prime Minister of Russia emphasized that this zone is among the five largest copper deposits in the world and contains significant reserves of gold, silver, and molybdenum. Exploration of the deposit will support the development of the whole Chukotka Autonomous District. It will help speed up achievement of federal goals, such as increasing the cargo turnover of the Northern Sea Route and the development of the Arctic zone as a whole. The agreement on the investment project entitled 'Exploration of deposits in the Baimsky Ore Zone' was signed at the EEF in September 2018. The project includes a mining and processing plant, as well as all the necessary infrastructure.

Kamchatka asks the Government to keep energy tariffs in the Far Eastern Federal District down to Russia's average

"Without this programme, today most of our operations would pay for electric energy based on its generation cost, which is roughly RUB 15 per kWh," said Dmitry Korostelyov, Acting Deputy Chairman of Kamchatka Territory Government. Presently, Kamchatka's operations pay RUB 6.78 per kWh. Local agricultural companies get a regional compensation for electric energy in the amount of RUB 300 million annually. The energy tariff for local residents has been stable since 2016 and is RUB 4.68.

Russian President ordered to develop the national programme for the Far East Development until 2025 in September 2018.

Almost 60 thousand new jobs created in the Far East through federal support

As of today, state support measures helped create almost 60 thousand new jobs at 330 new facilities, while the total amount of investment exceeded RUB 1 trillion. Over the last five years, the cumulative industrial growth in the Far East reached 32.4%, while it's 13.9% on average in Russia. The forecasts of the Ministry for the Development of the Far East and Arctic indicate that by 2025 the number of new facilities will go up to at least 1.2 thousand, with over 100 thousand new jobs and over RUB 3 trillion of investment.

Amur Gas Chemical Complex: the project commenced

The first test pile went into the ground at the complex construction site. The project provides for constructing a base polymer complex in Amur Region. Its total capacity will reach 2.7 mln. tonnes annually: 2.3 mln. tonnes of polyethylene and 400 thousand tonnes of polypropylene. Total budget of constructing Amur Gas Chemical Complex is estimated at USD 10–11 billion.

The Far East intends to launch unmanned aerial services

Sakhalin Region will be the first region to launch unmanned aerial services. It was announced by the Far East Investment and Export Agency. The plan is to start aerial services for pollination and watering, as well as for providing FPL services to federal postal and e-commerce services. If this project proves to be successful, it will be launched in other Far Eastern regions.

A ferry line between Primorye, the Republic of Korea, and Japan will be launched before 2021

The project targets Korean tourists that would like to visit Vladivostok. At the same time, the ferry will also be used for cargo transportation. Hanchang Ferry Cruise (Korea) plans to launch a new ferry line before 2021. It will connect Primorye Territory with Sokcho-si (the Republic of Korea) and Hokkaido (Japan). Earlier, this plan was endorsed by the leadership of the three countries.
