NArFU to contribute to Arctic development, says Trutnev

The draft programme for the development of the Northern (Arctic) Federal University named after M.V. Lomonosov (NArFU) in Arkhangelsk for 2021–2035 has been approved on the federal level. As part of the programme, the university is to contribute to the development of the Russian Arctic.

According to Minister for the Development of the Russian Far East Alexander Kozlov, the new strategic plan for the Arctic that has been brought before the Government puts an increased focus on NArFU as the only federal university in the Arctic. It is to become a highly competitive world-class scientific and educational centre.

Ministry for the Development of the Russian Far East plans to recreate the system for permafrost monitoring

The state of permafrost has an impact on the construction of the new facilities and condition of the previously built ones. The ministry's experts together with researchers plan to recreate the monitoring system that will allow to keep an eye on the state of permafrost in the Russian Arctic and forecast the risks caused by its degradation. The project of the system recreation is due the end of this year, said Alexander Kozlov to the media.

Ministry for the Development of the Russian Far East suggests amendments to the legislation concerning investors' activities in the Arctic and Far Eastern shelf area

A draft federal law 'On amending certain legislative acts of the Russian Federation regarding the specifics of the regulation of subsoil use related to the resource development on the continental shelf of the Russian Federation in the Arctic and Pacific oceans' has been prepared. It establishes a new model for investors' activities in the Arctic and Far Eastern shelf of Russia. According to the authors of the document, there is a pressing issue of replenishment of declining field production in Western Siberia. Among the its potential sources are the Arctic and Far Eastern shelves. Nadezhdinskaya ASEZ in Primorye has attracted more than RUB 50 billion of investment over the last five years

The Nadezhdinskaya advanced special economic zone (ASEZ) that was created in Primorye five years ago and was one of the first Far Eastern ASEZs, exceeded the target for attracting private investment more than by 50%. Since 2015, the total amount of investment topped RUB 50 billion. As of now, 62 Nadezhdinskaya residents are implementing their projects; they plan to create at least 5,000 jobs.

Nizhny Bestyakh cargo terminal to become a new river gate of the Arctic

It is designed to facilitate transportation of essential cargos to the Arctic. This has become a problem over the last decades due to the shallowing of the River Lena – one of Yakutia's main transport corridors. The investment portfolio of the Nizhny Bestyakh Cargo Terminal company reaches RUB 3.19 billion, with 190 jobs to be created. The total capacity of the terminal will be 2 million tonnes of cargo per year. The project is to be completed in 2023.

The cost of the bridge to Yelena Island in Vladivostok has been announced

The estimated and maximum cost of the bridge across the Eastern Bosphorus strait in Vladivostok will be around RUB 60 billion. The decree on allocation of funds for the technological and price audit of the project has been signed. The construction length of the bridge crossing will be 10 kilometres, with 2,026 linear metres of the bridge itself. The construction of the Vladivostok Ring Road is to be supported by the public-private partnership. The bridge concept was presented at the 5th Eastern Economic Forum by the St. Petersburg design institute that worked on the Russky and Zolotoy bridges. https://www.newsvl.ru/vlad/2020/06/07/190667/

The airport's passenger traffic will be tripled – up to 1.5 million people per year. The area of the terminal will be expanded from 5,000 to 6,500 sq.m, and the airport building will be equipped with two jet bridges. FEFU schoolers created a neural network that can regulate traffic

Schoolers from the Far Eastern Federal University (FEFU) team developed a PointsMan service for traffic light optimization and regulation. It can help make vehicle and pedestrian traffic safer and more comfortable, and less time-consuming. With this project the schoolers made it to the top three at the Skill Up national online hackathon for IoT and computer vision. The app took just three days to develop based on machine learning, IoT, computer vision and neural networks.

Windpark based on a unique Russian technology to be constructed in the Far East

Innovation Systems group of companies is to build a windpark in the Far Eastern Federal District using the double-rotor wind turbine technology. The project is be supported by the Far East Investment and Expert Agency. The windfarm's efficiency is 2.5 times higher than that of its foreign counterparts of the same capacity, which significantly reduces the prime cost of the produced energy. The windfarms are designed to work with relatively low wind speed -8-9 metres per second.
