

Natural Gas Conference took place on Sakhalin

Investment projects to double Magadan Region's GRP by 2024

Investment projects that are planned to be implemented in Magadan Region by 2024 will take the gross regional product up by 40%. Preliminary estimate shows that in 2019 the Region's GRP in 2019 went up 2.7% and reached RUB 181.2 bln. At the same time, Magadan Region's mining industry – the key one there – is responsible for almost two-thirds of this result. tass.ru/ekonomika/8051897

Rural doctors and teachers income tax exempt

According to Vladimir Putin's instruction, starting from 1 January 2020 participants of the Rural Doctor and Rural Teacher programmes that relocated to rural areas in the Far Eastern Federal District, high latitudes or the Arctic will get a higher non-recurring compensation. Now, it reached RUB 1 million. These compensations for rural doctors and teachers will be fully income tax exempt regardless of their amount.

Selection mechanism for investment projects in the Arctic approved

The Government of the Russian Federation approved the selection rules for the projects to be implemented in Russia's Arctic Zone. Companies will be able to obtain federal aid for building the required infrastructure. The Resolution was signed by Mikhail Mishustin.

If their projects qualify, companies will be able to receive a subsidy of up to 20% of the announced private investment in the infrastructure facilities required for the completion of those projects. tass.ru/ekonomika/8027297

Vladimir Putin approved Russia's state policy in the Arctic

Vladimir Putin signed the Decree "On the fundamental principles of the Russian Federation's state policy in the Arctic until 2035". The Decree defines the state policy goals as follows: improving the quality of life for the population of Russia's Arctic Zone, including small-numbered peoples; accelerating economic development of the Arctic Zone and increasing their input in the country's economic growth; ensuring environmental protection in the Arctic, protection of primordial living conditions and traditional lifestyles of small-numbered peoples.

Kamchatka is 49 points up in youth policy rating over two years

"Over the last two years, Kamchatka Territory is 49 points up in the federal rating. We now rank 35 in Russia and third in the Far East. For many reasons, these results were attainable due to infrastructure development in Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky. The city now has a palace of youth and a youth centre. These venues are never empty, not even for a day. Younger generation is active and attends federal forums. Yakutia's Arctic areas to get three trade and logistics centres

According to Yakutia's Ministry of Agriculture, developing a network of trade and logistics centres will drive food prices down and resolve food storage problems.

Severny Zavoz (Northern Delivery) is delivery of food, medical supplies and fuel to remote villages and whole areas, including Arctic ones. Those places stay disconnected from the rest of the country for several months every winter due to a harsh climate. Summer navigation is used to bring food, coal, petrochemicals, and other essentials to remote rural areas in Yakutia. Rosatom plans to start construction of small land based NPP in 2024

Rosatom State Corporation expects to obtain a license for a land based low-power nuclear power plant in Yakutia and start construction works the same year. In this case, the facility may be put into operation in 2027.

During the EEF 2019, Rosatom and Yakutia signed a cooperation agreement for constructing low-power NPPs.

Russia to launch flights from Magadan to Krasnovarsk

The authorities of Magadan Region consider launching a flight from Magadan to Krasnoyarsk. These plans derive from Aeroflot's intentions to start 12 new flights from Krasnoyarsk to Simferopol, Sochi, Ekaterinburg, Tyumen, Tomsk, Omsk, Novosibirsk, Bratsk, Irkutsk, Yakutsk, Beijing, and Sanya (China). Far East might get modern system to diagnose and treat cancer

The Far East Investment and Export Agency is working together with the Ministry for the Development of the Far East and a number of Far Eastern regions to review the possibility of creating a new system to diagnose and treat cancer in the District. A nuclear medicine centre will be a public-private partnership project. A Far Eastern subsidy in the amount of RUB 400 mln. will be allocated after Vladimir Putin signed a decree making Buryatia a part of the Far Eastern Federal District. The rest of the funds will be provided by a concessionaire – Ulan-Ude Centre of Nuclear Medicine.

Remote villages in Khabarovsk Territory to use solar energy

Hevel LLC will construct self-sustainable hybrid power units as part of solar power plants in the communities that have diesel generators with a total annual output of over 1 mln. kWh.
