On 10 September 2018 the Russian Historical Society and the National History Foundation will present a photo exhibition of archival documents and photos for the Year of Russia in Japan and Year of Japan in Russia at the Eastern Economic Forum (campus of the Far Eastern Federal University, passage from Building A to Building C).

The exhibits are provided by the archival subdivisions of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia and leading federal archives and illustrate the main stages of Russian-Japanese relations, starting from the missions of Adam Laxman and Nikolai Rezanov to Japan and their first bilateral diplomatic agreements to the modern day.

The exhibition is organized as part of the project of bilateral cross-cultural years, 'Japan Year in Russia' and 'Russia Year in Japan', implemented in accordance with the agreements of the President of the Russian Federation Vladimir Putin and the Prime Minister of Japan Shinzō Abe, which is to include more than 300 events in both countries.
