

The business programme of the Eastern Economic Forum 2019 consists of blocks on accelerating economic growth, improving quality of life in the Far East, new business environment and collaboration in Asia Pacific.

Apart from that, the programme features a number of business dialogues: Russia–China, Russia–Japan, Russia–India, Russia–ASEAN, Russia–Republic of Korea. On the EEF sidelines, the Russian-Chinese Media Forum, High-Level Russia–Singapore Intergovernmental Commission, and 'A Common Economic Space from the Atlantic to the Pacific' Conference will be held.

Preparations for the visit of the Indian Prime Minister to EEF were discussed in Moscow

Advisor to the President of the Russian Federation Anton Kobyakov and Ambassador of the Republic of India to the Russian Federation Venkatesh Varma discussed the preparation for the participation of the Indian delegation in the 5th Eastern Economic Forum. Process of receiving deposits in the Arctic and in the Far East has been facilitated

The declarative principle of provision of subsurface sites for geological exploration at entrepreneurial risk has been expanded to the areas with identified prognostic solid mineral resources of P1 and P2 categories in the Far East and the Arctic.

According to Deputy Minister for the Development of the Russian Far East and Arctic Alexander Krutikov, "it is a great impetus for private investment into geological exploration and follow-up exploration of deposits." It is expected that the new process will help increase such investments by 20–30% annually.

2% mortage to be launched in the Far East before the end of the year

A. Kozlov announced the launch time of the preferential mortgage for residents of the Far Eastern regions. Credits with 2% rate will be given for purchase, renovation and construction of residential properties for up to 20 years without initial installment. For this purpose, around 15 billion roubles were allocated from the budget.

Chinese investor launched a new wood processing production in Primorye

The resident of the Free Port of Vladivostok, Runda wood processing company, launched the production of OSB boards and plywood in Ussuriysk. The facility hosts plywood, maintenance and transport departments, as well as a wood storage. The total worth of the project is 154.5 million roubles.

Wasteless wood processing production is targeted at the internal market and will supply to customers from Primorye and other Far Eastern regions. The annual production plan is 35,000 square metres of OSB boards, formwork and plywood.

Gazprom opened an R&D centre on Russky Island for implementation of offshore projects

The new centre specializes in coordination of research and development of offshore petroleum production and natural gas liquefication. In particular, the R&D centre will do the research as part of the construction of the third train of the Sakhalin-2 LNG plant, the medium-scale LNG plant near Vladivostok as well as the development of the Kirinskoye and Yuzhno-Kirinskoye oil and gas condensate fields.

Following the results of the Eastern Economic Forum 2018, Vladimir Putin tasked state corporations to open engineering departments on the Russky Island.
